## *Description of Location*

Green Cay is a highly successful man-made water reclamation habitat that emulates the Everglades with wide expanses of marsh habitat with intermittent tree islands and cypress hammocks. It is a home to alligators, marsh hares as well many native and migrating birds that can be seen during the fall and winter months. Artists will be able to set up and paint along the elevated 1.5 mile board walk. There are small shaded pavilions and a large Chickee hut provided for shade.

## *Special Instructions*

Please bring sun screen, bug repellent, rain gear and a hat. The weather can range from comfortable to hot and muggy with afternoon showers. There are rest rooms available. I have been informed that a limit of 20 artists has been suggested and we can not block the boardwalk as the facility is open to the public. There are restaurants and grocery stores nearby. Free admission and there is a visitor's center but no snacks. We will meet in the parking lot.

## *Directions*

From I-95 exit at Woolbright Road and head west 6.1 miles to Hagen Ranch Road, go south (turn left) drive 1.9 miles. Green Cay is on the left. Coming from the turnpike, Exit Boynton Beach Boulevard head east and turn right at Hagen Ranch Road. Drive 1.9 miles Green Cay is on the left.
